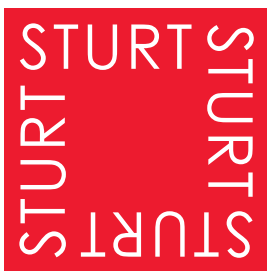

Explore modern and medieval methods to lay gold leaf and burnish it to a mirror finish, and to make paint from semi-precious stones including Lapis Lazuli, Orpiment, Malachite and Cinnabar. You will learn ancient and modern techniques for creating illuminated capital letters and borders. A wide choice of decorative projects will be offered suitable for framing, a gift or starting a text or design your own. Equally suitable for beginners and those with experience.

Peter Taylor is a highly experienced teacher who initially studied in London with the Society of Scribes and Illuminators. His professional practice includes many prestigious commissions and four calligraphy and papercrafts books published in Australia, UK and NZ.

MATERIALS LIST

SUMMER 2018

3-7 January

Please bring with you:

- H or 2H pencil
- 30cm clear plastic ruler
- UHU glue stick (any size – small will be fine)
- Eraser (cylindrical eraser refills that fit inside 'click' erasers are particularly good)
- Bottle of cheap black fountain-pen ink – eg Pelikan 4001, Parker Quink...
- Water container and paint-mixing surfaces eg Yoghurt tub and 4 lids or plastic plate
- A top quality round and pointed pure sable watercolour brush, size 00 for painting finest lines and small corners (Don't buy one specially. I will have some for loan or bargain price purchase)
- A lesser but reasonable quality round and pointed brush for painting with glue, Size 0
- A lesser but reasonable quality brush for covering larger areas and for mixing paint, Size 1 or 2
- 0.1 Uni-Pin fine line pen – black (from Officeworks or newsagent)
- 0.1 Uni-Pin, Pitt or similar fine line pen – red ...for adding small dots around letters
- Scissors
- Craft knife with a straight and solid blade, eg 'Stanley knife' (...and Band Aid?)
- 4 Bulldog/fold back clips – any size
- 1 full sheet of smooth hot pressed watercolour paper or about 3 A3 sheets (Cut it smaller for travelling if you wish – you will probably not use areas larger than A3)
- Pair of thin cotton gloves and pair of thin plastic gloves
- Bring a cup for your morning tea

Optional DO NOT BUY ANY OF THESE SPECIALLY:

- Masking tape
- Steel ruler or metal straight edge
- Thimble
- Pliers (for pulling a needle)
- Awl
- More pointed craft knife than a Stanley knife – eg Exacto or a scalpel with a No 11 blade
- Magnifying glass if you think it will help you to see and paint small details
- PVA glue eg Aquadhere woodworking glue
- Any calligraphy pens that you already own (pens will be available to be borrowed)
- Any coloured pens or pencils you own and like using for fun projects, eg gel-pens, felt-pens...
- Any watercolour or gouache paints that you already own and like using
- Choices of paper will be included and extras available from the shop, but bring any fancy paper that you think you may like to use for a finished artwork or bookbinding eg, Canson Mi-Tientes...
- Coloured embroidery silk for bookbinding, and beads for fun attachments
- 25 sheet pack of 90 gsm A4 parchment paper (Officeworks - \$8.50) for finished work and bookbinding pages – your colour choice
- A light-pad or light-box if you own one and it's convenient to bring it.
- A drawing board (or square cut rectangle of 12mm thick MFD wood A3 size or a fraction larger)
- A Tee-square or large set-square
- Paper-trimmer / guillotine
- Cutting mat or board
