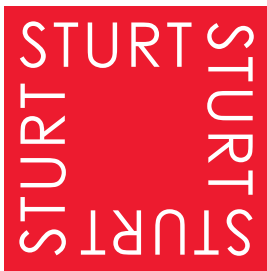
Look at folding as a design element! Working with paper to prototype and perforation of metal as a low tech decorative solution you will learn how to create objects and jewellery in the folded form. Learn techniques for folding; scoring, die folding and hammering as well as associated jewellery skills; saw piercing, soldering and roller embossing, going on to create your own project.

Christian Hall is a designer and maker specialising in metal whose practice encompasses jewellery and objects, sculpture, furniture and combines hand making with digital and industrial processes. Christian is currently the creative director of the JamFactory Jewellery and Metal Studio, Adelaide, designing and manufacturing items contributing to the JamFactory product range, creating bespoke commissioned work and overseeing the educational program and workshop.
