Learn to weave your own textured fabric using simple techniques and amazing yarns that shrink, collapse, felt, pleat and stretch. Discover how easy it is to use a double warp beam, double weave technique or even simple plain weave to create contemporary fabrics to wear or for the home. You will have the opportunity to play on pre-warped looms, experimenting with weaving techniques that create texture and highlight unusual threads, yarns and colours, selecting your favourite techniques and yarns to weave your own project.

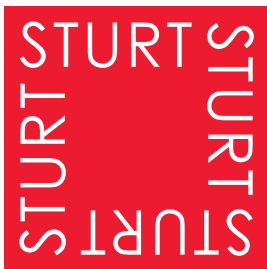
