The paintings in this exhibition are an inner response to the outside world whether it is a still life, an interior or a landscape and the resulting body of work covers the last 4 years of Denise's output. All the works are inspired by the local surroundings of the artist's home in the Southern Highlands.

Mark making and calligraphy are a common thread through all the works that Denise has produced but it is the rhythm of the seasons and the changes that they bring that are the inspiration for these new works.

Denise Sumner studied at the Royal Art Society from 1968-71 and worked under Henry Hanke, Arthur Murch, Joshua Smith, Garrett Kingsley and Fred Bates. Denise has exhibited extensively in Sydney and NSW and is the recipient of numerous awards and prizes.
