Learn the basic techniques of plant dyeing and imprinting of plant material onto cloth and paper. Discover the natural environment through colours, textures and collected plant material, mark making with natural dyes, rust dyeing and collage. Creating a set of samples you will explore their possibilities as a springboard to future work, making a small reference book of samples.

Kirsten Ingemar has worked as a textile artist and maker in Australia for over 25 years. Her work is a blend of different dyeing techniques, collage and stitching with plant dyeing and leaf imprinting being the focus of her exploration. Kirsten has been teaching in diverse settings, including COFA in Sydney, Flying Arts in Queensland and numerous workshops around the country.

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MATERIALS LIST

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Please bring with you:

ESSENTIAL

- A variety of fabrics – **natural fibres ONLY**. Mainly whites or natural, 3-5 m in total.
- A good selection will include silk, wool, cotton & possibly a couple of other fibres, as well as 1m. of muslin.
- Good quality watercolour paper (approx 2 large sheets hot pressed)
- Old sheet (s)
- A good variety of needles and threads, different colours and threads for stitching and layering.
- Scissors for paper and fabric.
- Any other stuff you might want to use for collage.
- Wooden pegs.
- 3-4 Glass jars (500gr)
- Found or collected objects that interests you.
- Rubber Gloves.
- Plastic Bucket.
- Bring a cup for your morning tea.

IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THESE PLEASE BRING:

- Dye pots: Large preferably stainless steel pots 15-25 L
- Camping stoves or other gas burners including gas bottle.
- Electric hotplate will also do.
- G-Clamps

Kirsten will also bring some silk fabric for students to buy by the meter if they wish to.
