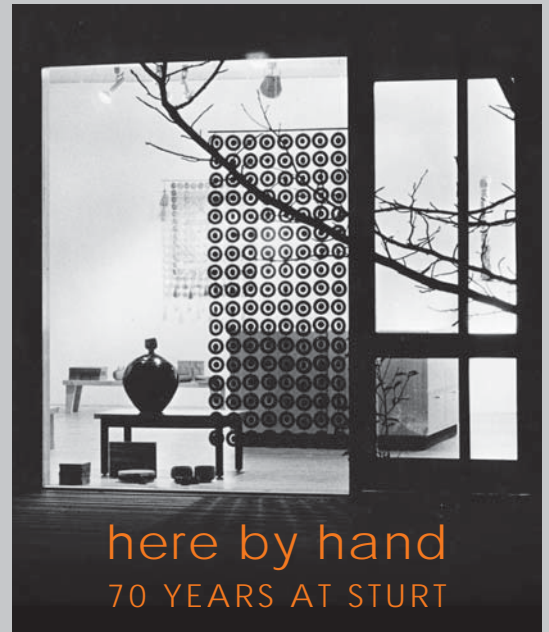

An exhibition of new works by **Slavica Zivkovic** including mixed media and prints

14 August to 25 September

In this exhibition a backdrop of multilayers of lino and screen-printing are interwoven as a form of storytelling. This foundation is followed by imagery which creates a narrative of personal myth. Drawing inspiration from her personal experience and reflections of travel which include a deep interest in ancient cultures, Slavica interprets the internal journey.

The imagery in the exhibition oscillates between the inner & outer experiences that deeply resonate from listening to, and observing, the voice of intuition. In narrative form they become small chapters depicting experiences and weave to form an evolving story line that is continuously changing.

The exhibition will be opened on Sunday 14 August at 11am by special guest Andrew Antoniou R.E., painter and lecturer. Refreshments will be served.

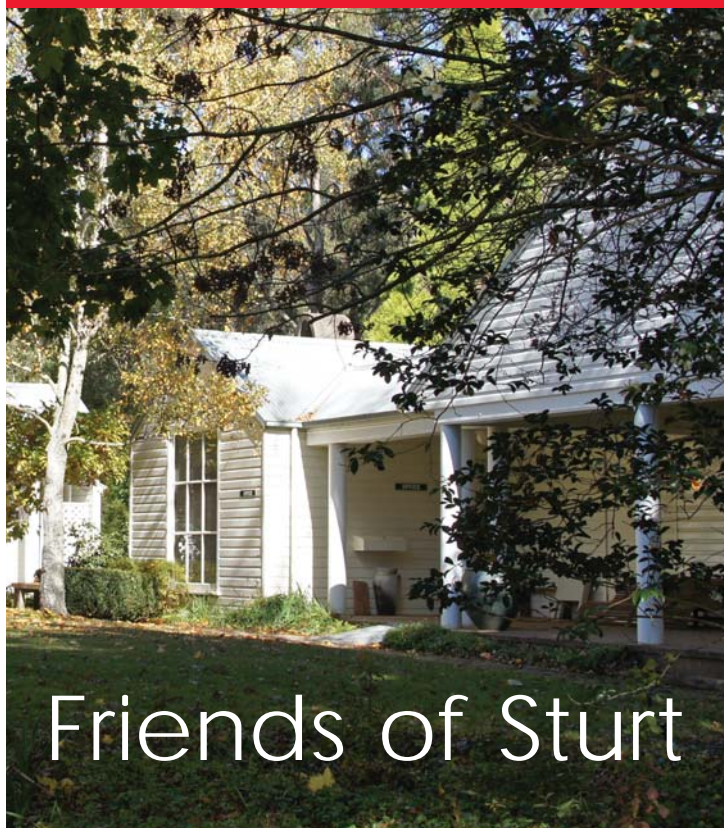

Funds raised by *Friends of Sturt* directly support the Artist-in-Residence program.

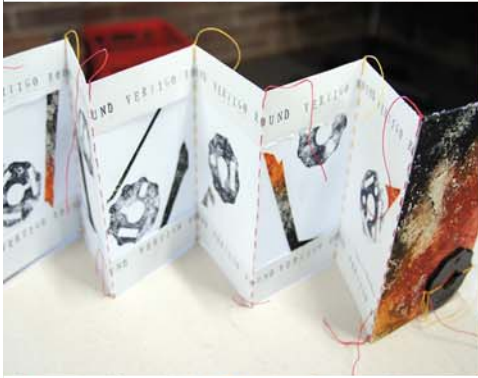
Members of *Friends of Sturt* are united by the love of fine craft and art, and a desire to support Sturt. As well, members enjoy a range of benefits including:
