This course is designed **for those with some throwing skills**. Students will be guided by instruction with master potter Lino Alvarez, to make a wide range of pots from ovenware to large vessels. Students will learn new skills to give their throwing much greater fluency and confidence. Processes will include making cylinders, which are then turned up side down, to be extended into making large pots, as well as many other techniques. This week will be a wonderful opportunity for students to benefit from learning from one of Australia's most experienced and versatile throwers, who comes from a culture of traditional ceramic making.

**Lino Alvarez** is a Mexican ceramicist from Sonora, who settled in Australia in 1981. He established La Paloma Pottery in Newtown in Sydney, and quickly marked himself as a maker of very large ceramic vessels. He has worked with architects and interior designers, as well as artists such as Gary Shead and Elizabeth Cummings. Lino now works from Hill End, near Bathurst NSW, and works on a range of projects including exhibition work, commissions, collaborations, cookware and domestic ware, architectural work, murals, raku and decorated ware.

The Summer School runs for 5½ days between Monday 4<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> January and the classes are held from 9am to 4.30pm (12.30 on Saturday). Tea and coffee are provided.
