Learn how to felt wool fibre through woven fabric using wool/fabric prefelts in your designs. The focus of the workshop is about creating a piece of clothing that drapes beautifully and on which the surface decoration is intricately worked using the prefelted layers of fabric. **This workshop is suitable for all.**

**Catherine O'Leary** is a textile artist who has taught and exhibited in Australia and overseas. She has been a feltmaker for the past 20 years and her work has been included in feltmaking books and publications and she has successfully sold her felt jackets and clothing through her label *Catherine O'Leary Designs* in Australia, New Zealand and Korea.

# felted body wrap

with Catherine O'Leary

## Please bring the following items

- 3 metres Bubble wrap plastic (between 1 m -1.5metre wide)
- 1 rod (wooden dowel, or pvc pipe, or swimming pool noodle) width of bubble plastic
- 3 metres thin painter's plastic
- 1 small rod (noodle) 50cm length
- 3 metres white tissue silk
- 3 metres black tissue silk
- 6 lots of half metre lengths coloured, printed or patterned fine silk fabric
- \*note, silk gauze, devore, chiffon, georgette acceptable
- Any old sheer silk, viscose or rayon scarves, NO POLYESTER
- Mixed colours of merino wool tops to make up 200 grams
- Needlefelted merino wool, variety of colours that make up 4 metres (available from fibre fusions)
- Biodegradable dishwashing detergent or soap, eg olive oil soap
- Needle and cottons
- Pure wool knitting yarn (small quantity for stitching)
- Scissors
- 2 old towels
- Water bottle with holes drilled through the lid
- A mug for your tea or coffee
