Design and construct two different two bands rings using hot (soldering) and cold (riveting) joints. Learn different techniques for each method and how to select which to use for different functional or decorative effects. Different textures for finishing will be taught, including highly polished, brushed and hammered. By week's end, each student should have completed two different rings from concept through the design process to making, finishing and then wearing.

This class is for those with some prior experience in silversmithing.

Marcelo Zavala-Baeza's background is in Industrial Design and Jewellery and Object Design. His recent work focuses on metals as the main media to construct his designs. He creates a wide range of objects including jewellery, hollow ware, lighting and furniture for commercial and artistic purposes. He is a co-director of Smug designs - a jewellery company making and selling both in Australia and overseas.

The Summer School runs for 5½ days between Monday 4th and Saturday 9th January and the classes are held from 9am to 4.30pm (12.30 on Saturday). Tea and coffee are provided.

- a silver cloth
- cotton rags or drying cloth
- a mug for your tea or coffee

If you have any of the following and would like to bring your own tools, clearly mark them with your name

- vernier callipers
- small metal ruler
- square
- scribe
- piercing saw
- various files (round, flat, etc)
- tweezers and cross locking tweezers
- jewellery pliers (round, half round, flat and parallel)
- a leather or plastic mallet
- centre punch and hammer

The above items will be supplied if you do not have your own. Your material fee will cover silver etc for the two rings outlined in the course. If you wish to make extra items, you may purchase further materials from the tutor.
