Explore the wonderful possibilities of piece dyeing. Participants will experience a variety of fibres, including cotton, silk, wool, rayon and monofilament and weave structures (supplementary warp and weft, honey comb, twills) on shared warps using table looms. The woven results will be transformed into totally different cloths using several types of dyes (both synthetic and natural). This workshop is suitable **for people with basic weave knowledge**.

All yarns will be provided but if you have any natural or white yarn you are welcome to bring that as well.

Monique Van Nieuwland has been a weaver for more than 30 years and has exhibited her work since 1985. Monique's work encompasses loom weaving, jacquard weaving, printing with pigments and dyes as well as mixed media. She produces a range of scarves and table runners and takes private & public commissions.

The Summer School runs for 5½ days between Monday 4th and Saturday 9th January and the classes are held from 9am to 4.30pm (12.30 on Saturday). Tea and coffee are provided.
