Make a solid timberside table from beginning to end, starting with the preparation of components using a variety of machine and hand skill processes. This will include the thicknesser, tablesaw and hand planing techniques. Learn methods of joinery required in constructing a high quality table, and finally sanding and finishing. The project has been specifically designed to teach **absolute beginners** some of the fundamentals in fine furniture construction. Be part of a real woodwork experience in the purpose built Sturt School for Wood workshop.

Students are required to bring ear and dust protection, safety glasses/ visor, pencil and notebook, a mug for your tea or coffee and wear solid footwear in the workshop.

John Gallagher runs his own fine furniture studio practice (Piece Furniture) in Sydney and is a part-time teacher at the Sturt School for Wood. He specialises in one-off commissioned pieces for both private and commercial clients. His work is characterised by contemporary, practical design coupled with traditional high quality craftsmanship and attention to detail. John is a past graduate of the Sturt School for Wood and has exhibited widely.

The Summer School runs for 5½ days between Monday 4th and Saturday 9th January and the classes are held from 9am to 4.30pm (12.30 on Saturday). Tea and coffee are provided.
