Kids will learn both sculpting and painting skills during the exciting creative process of this course. They will make weird and wonderful objects, inspired by the works of artists such as Picasso and Dali, from surprising everyday and recycled materials and then paint these magical creations.

We will look at and discuss the work of artists such as Pablo Picasso and Salvador Dali. This process will let our imaginations create our own wonderful images which we will shape into faces, figures or purely abstract forms using stockings, wire, and recycled materials. Throughout the process we will make experimental drawings and paintings. Participants will be able to take home two or three sculptures and some beautiful work to hang on the wall.

Sue Meredith is a local artist who has been encouraging kids' creativity for 13 years, both in Sydney and in the Southern Highlands, through creative play-sessions and art classes. She has exhibited her work in NSW and in the Highlands and is working towards her second solo exhibition. She has worked as graphic designer, illustrator and visual artist in Australia and overseas.

All materials will be provided. Children are to wear an old shirt or apron, and to bring their own lunch (or you may order lunch at time of enrolment). Morning tea is provided.

The Kids Program of the Summer School runs for 3 days between Wednesday 6th and Friday 8th January and the classes are held from 9am to 2.30pm.
