

While playing with pastels, delve into diverse application techniques and paper choices as you explore elements and principles of design to gain confidence in composing great landscapes, cityscapes, still life and more.

* As an Accredited Unison artist Tricia has been given her own selections of Unison pastel sets that can be ordered from her website: www.taylorart.com.au Please bring with you:

- Pastels Bring whatever you have. A 60 set with a variety of tones in warm
 and cool colours would be a minimum. (If you are a beginner and looking for
 a set to buy contact Tricia and she shall advise)
 - Tricia recommends her Unison sets:
 - "Tricia Taylor Seascape" sets 63 half sticks. Or "Rock and Earth" set. Or a beginner set of 63 Half sticks. See website for details: www.taylorart.com.au
- Backing board padded with 5 layers of butchers paper.
- Easel table or standing
- Paper Art Spectrum colourfix
- 2 x A3 sheet White or clear (or 1 full sheet you can cut it in half to travel if you want to)
- 1 x A3 sheet Terracotta
- 2 x A3 sheet Storm Blue (or 1 full sheet)
- 1 x full sheet Fresh Grey
- Kneadable eraser
- Paint brush old to remove pastel.
- Apron or work clothes
- Disposable gloves*
- Willow charcoal
- Set of watercolours*
- 5 x old large 1" brushes to underpaint.
- Rubbing alcohol* (Isocol)
- Mug for morning tea and water bottle

 exercises but you learn more from painting your own references. Tricia will be working
 with landscapes, skies, cityscapes and still life.
