
Create a beautiful cube stool, 'Sit the Cube Down' designed by Sturt School for Wood Graduate and resident, Steve Giannuzzi. Using New Guinea Rosewood and cotton webbing you'll explore machine cut, three-way mitres plus hand and machine shaped components. Be guided in the use of the Festool Domino machine and in the techniques of weaving the seamless cotton seat.

Steve Giannuzzi graduated from Sturt's School for Wood in 2019, after beginning his journey in furniture as a cabinet maker and joiner. Steve has worked at Sturt in residence since and is much sought after for commissions and projects for his discerning clientele.

His work is represented by Sturt Gallery and Bungendore Wood Works Gallery and graces public places and homes all over Australia.
